Glorifying God With Your Talents

A talent is something that you were born with that gives you unique skills and abilities. Talent is different from knowledge because it is not a learned behavior, although it can be strengthened and practiced. The Bible tells us that we are all born with distinct talents and gifts that set us apart from each other.

When you discover the talents that God has given you and you use them to glorify Him, it brings such a joy to your life! We each have a unique calling on our lives and God has gifted us with talents to use. You have more skills and strengths than you may realize. It is often easier to see others' skills or talents than it is to see our own gifts or capabilities.

A young man used his musical talent along with his social media following to hold a benefit concert to raise funds for Treasure audio Bibles.


Two very talented artists used their skills to paint beautiful artwork that was sold to raise funds to reach people who have never heard of Jesus.
